If you are being stalked online

Keep a documentary evidence and contact local police

If you genuinely believe that you might be at risk of online stalking, keep a documentary evidence and contact local police.

Do not respond to them in any form

Give a clear message to the person that is not rude, insulting or personal, that they must stop contacting you in social media.

End all communications immediately

If you feel uncomfortable end all communications immediately and report to Police. Block that person or profile from your social media platform.

Save all communications with the harasser

If someone use bad language or threatens, take a screen shot of your conversation and tell them that you would report to police.

Be aware of personal information when you post in global address group-

Always use a nickname or alias name to sign into a chat room

On the internet, it is easy to pretend to be someone else. Some people take advantage of the relative anonymity offered by the net to lie about their age occupation, and intentions.

Always take advantage of security settings available on social networking sites

Make sure to set your profile to private on social networking sites so that strangers cannot view your personal information.

Never send your photograph thought email to unknown persons
