

Beware of fake job offer

Tips-

- Don't believe anyone who says they can get you through companies by "back-door"
- To reduce the change of being scammed, use job sites that have privacy policies and only allow verified employers to view the listings.
- Think twice before paying money to any of the job sites.
- Look at the email address carefully, then copy /paste it into the search box. You can also the in the word 'scam' after the email address to see if someone else has reported the company.
- When searching for information about the company, search for both the company's name and the emails address. Also, copy/paste paragraphs from the email into the search box. Scammers may change the company name but re-use the other parts of the email, and it's possible you'll find an identical email posted online.
- Before entering personal information online, check to make sure the website is secure by looking at the web address bar. The address should be.

Immediate action

- In case if police station is very far from your place, you may also file a report through email to the email id – mpcyberpolice@mppolice.gov.in.
- Explain your situation that what the job was promised and how were duped.
- Before you submit your complaint to cyber cell police, you must confirm that the website you have paid to is a fake website.
